ROB MONTGOMERY,

VARSITY "AA" COACH

Rob Montgomery is a Bismarck native. He played on Bismarck's last State Championship team in 1971. After completing high school and playing on the Bismarck squad in 1972, he moved on to play baseball at BJC, the fall of 1972. In 1973, he transferred to Mayville State College. At Mayville, he lettered three years. He was named Captain of the M.S.C. baseball team his junior and senior years. During his career at Mayville, he earned many awards culminating with being named honorable mention All-American in 1976. This will be Rob's fifth year as Bismarck's varsity coach. He has been involved with the Bismarck program as either a player or a coach since 1970. He currently is teaching and coaching in Wilton.



JIM KOCH, VARSITY ASSISTANT and JUNIOR VARSITY COACH

Jim Koch played five years of Legion baseball in Mandan; playing on two state championship teams in 1964-65 and 1965-66 seasons. He attended U.N.D. and played four years of college baseball. Was also involved in amateur baseball for two years. Jim coached the Grand Forks Legion team to a state championship in 1972. Being a teacher, he taught at West Fargo and coached football for three years. Jim just finished teaching in Europe for the past four years where he coached basketball and football. He currently is teaching in Linton and coaching basketball.




AL BREUER, ROYALS COACH

Gene was the recipient of the Dakota Northwestern Bank sponsored "Gold Award" in December 1980, for his service and dedication to the youth of Bismarck.



BISMARCK AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL



The Bismarck 1981 American Legion baseball program will consist of three of four teams depending on the number of players that want to participate. Our goal in 1981 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The "AA" squad will play a forty-eight game schedule that will include a trip to the Rapid City Firecracker Tournament, July 3, 4, and 5, one of the finest Legion Baseball tournaments in the country. Post season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Mandan, and the State Tournament in Jamestown. The 1981 "AA" All-Star game is slated in Mandan July 12th.

Bismarck American Legion baseball will be expanded in 1981 to include a fourth team, a junion varsity squad, that will be closely linked to the "AA" squad. A thirty to forty game schedule is planned for the Junior Varsity in 1981. This team will depend on the total number of participants that will register, if we have the number of interested young men available we do plan to start a very structured program similar to our varsity for these young

people.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot and Williston. At the end of the regular season each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The State Tournament has a new structure this year. The two top finishers from each division will meet in an "AA" Tournament and the four regional "A" winners will meet in an "A" Tournament. There will be two state champions declared in these tournaments that will be conducted at the same field and run simultaneously. The two winners will then meet in a best-of-three series at the site of the "AA" winner to declare an overall state champion that will advance to national playoffs. The Champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to a National Tournament to determine the National Champion.

This season, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program will again sponsor two "A" teams, the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 15-18 players in the 14-16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately 35 games with practices beginning the middle of May and the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are

scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for the family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m. and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform, jacket and carrying bag. The players will need to furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome all players of this age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a better caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the 2-team concept will not require us to cut anyone from the program who has the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

The past three years the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club, that donates a substantial sum of money for this program, and by concerned businesses in the Bismarck-Mandan area. This financial assistance has enabled the Bismarck Legion Committee to administer a

fine program.

This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.


The Bismarck American Legion Baseball program along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also

co-sponsor the Bismarck Rookie League.

Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop the baseball and understand the game so as to become better participants and spectators.

The league consists basically of persons who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop the baseball skill of the players.

Coaches for Rookie League teams are volunteer adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.
