American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1984 American Legion Baseball program will consist of three teams. The Governors, Royals and Scarlets. Our goal in 1984 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 55 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Williston, and the State Tournament in Dickinson, the 1984 "AA" All-Star game is slated in Bismarck, July 29th.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The two top finishers from each division will meet in an "AA" Tournament and the four regional "A" winners will meet in an "A" Tournament. There will be two state champions declared in these tournaments that will be conducted in the same field and run simultaneously. The two winners will then meet in a best-of-three series at the site of the "AA" winner to declare an overall state champion that will advance to national playoffs. The champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to a National Tournament to determine the national champion.

This season, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program will again sponsor two "A" teams, the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 14 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately thirty-five games with practices beginning the middle of May and the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for the family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m. and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a

uniform, jacket and carrying bag. The players will need to furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome all players of this age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a better caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

The past four years the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club that donates a substantial sum of money for this program, and by concerned businesses in the Bismarck-Mandan area through donations and advertising in this program booklet. This financial assistance has enabled the Bismarck Legion Committee to administer a fine program.

This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the fame of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball program along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Rookie League.

Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The league consists basically of persons who have completed the 7th, 8th and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop the baseball skill of the players.

Coaches for Rookie League teams are volunteer adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball program.
