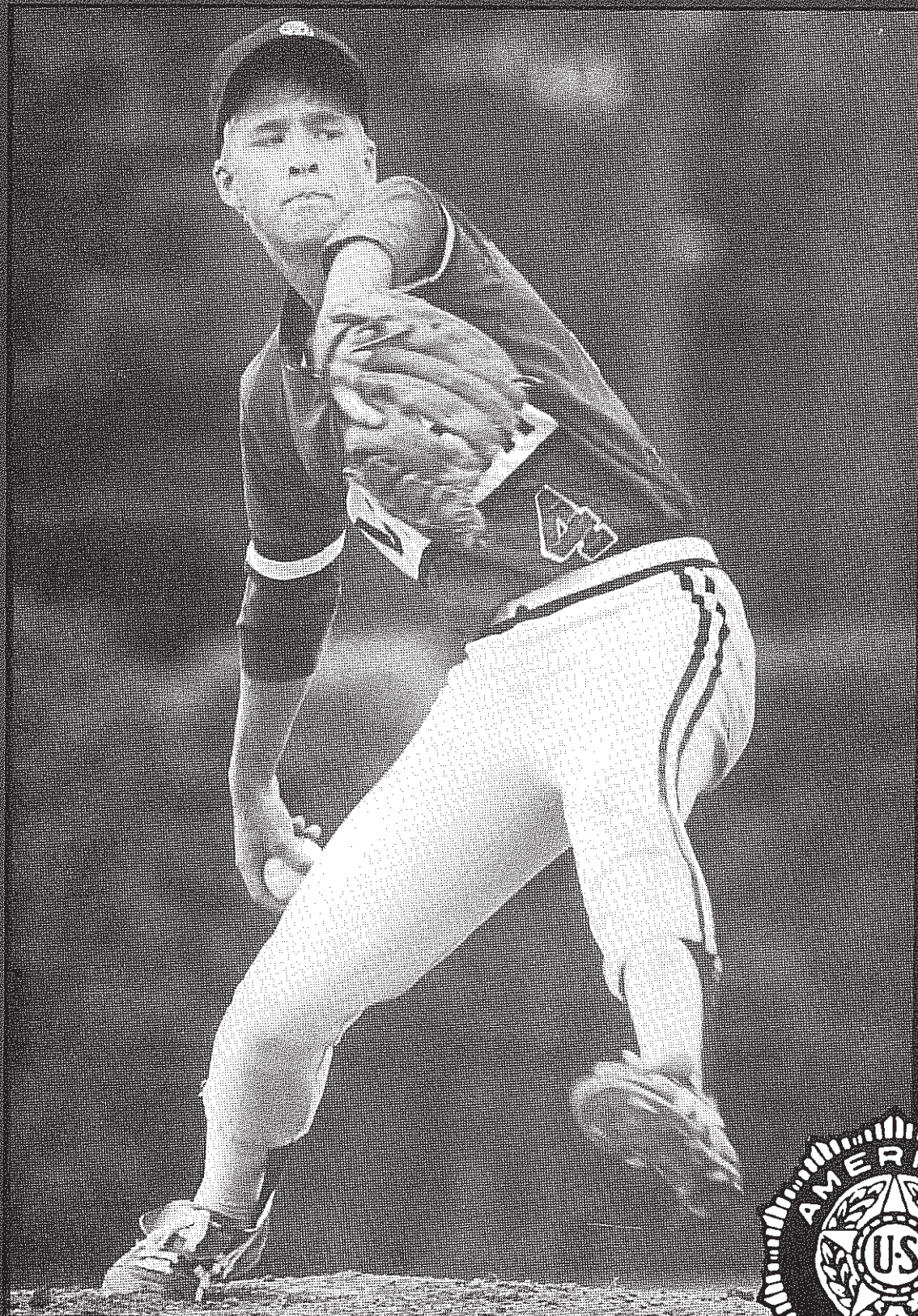

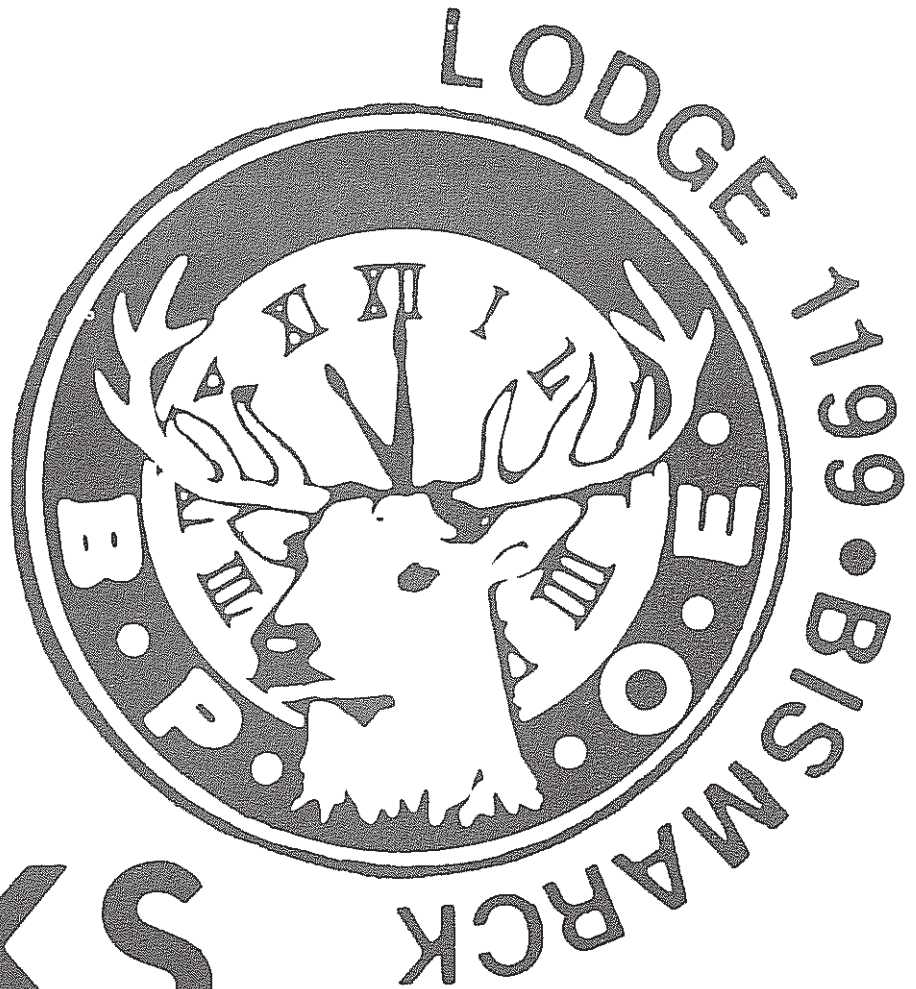

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# In Memorium

David W. Smith  
1964 - 1988

Dave Smith was a winner wherever he played. He began his American Legion baseball career with the Class A Bismarck Royals where he starred from 1978 through 1980 as a pitcher and centerfielder. In 1980, Dave was the pitching ace for the Royals, compiling a 7-0 regular season record as he led the Royals to victory in the Class A Southwest Regional Tourney and on to the Royals' first ever State Tournament berth.

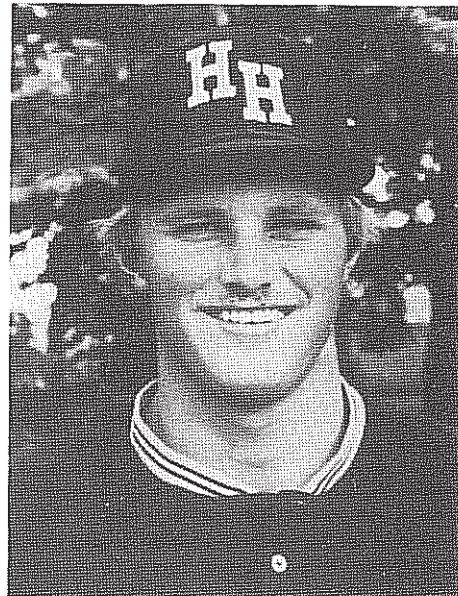
The next year, Dave moved up to the Class AA Bismarck Governors, establishing himself as an outstanding centerfielder with a rifle arm. The 1981 Governors' squad completed a successful year by advancing to the Class AA State Tournament.

The following year, 1982, was an exceptional senior year for Dave and for the Governors. In mid-July the Governors showed their potential as they won the Mountain States Realty Invitational American Legion Baseball Tournament in Casper, Wyoming. The Governors then continued on to win the Class AA Western Division season title and the Western Division Tournament to again earn a State Tournament berth. This time the Governors were not to be denied the championship as they defeated Fargo twice in the same day to win the Class AA State Tournament. Fargo had entered the day unbeaten in their first two state tournament games and sported a 20 game winning streak before running into a stone wall against the Governors.

The Governors next moved on to the Central Plains Regional Tournament in Fenton, Missouri where they started strong with a first game 10 to 5 victory over Omaha Charter. Dave's rifle arm came through twice for the Governors that August day as they triumphed over Omaha. His outstanding throw to home plate in the fourth inning prevented an Omaha run. He then proved his throw was no fluke the very next inning. With Omaha runners on second and third and one out, the Omaha batter hit what appeared to be a run-scoring sacrifice fly to centerfield. However, Dave Smith stood in the way. Dave caught

the fly ball and rifled a throw to catcher, Pat Spaeth who put the tag on the surprised Omaha runner attempting to score from third base for the final out of the inning.

The Bismarck Tribune reported that Coach Joe Warner was impressed by his team's clutch hits that day but was particularly elated about Dave Smith's two throws that nailed runners at the plate. "Those were big ones," Warner said.

Although the Governors were then edged in their final two tournament games, Dave and the Governors had completed an outstanding season. Dave finished the year with a .379 average, 3 doubles, 2 triples and 20 stolen bases.

Dave's baseball career was far from over, however, as the St. Mary's Central High School graduate continued his outstanding play for four more years of college ball, beginning with Bismarck Junior College from 1982

through 1984 and finishing with Minot State University from 1984 through 1986. Dave's college performance earned him spots on the North Dakota All-Conference Team in 1984, 1985 and 1986.

Following his graduation from Minot State, he continued his avid interest in sports - hunting and fishing whenever he had time and playing softball for the Hair Hospital team.

Despite his many physical triumphs in sports, Dave was stricken with cancer. Although he fought a valiant battle against the disease, he died on October 2, 1988, in a Rochester, Minnesota hospital at age 24.

Dave is survived by his wife, Pattie; two sons, Kyle and Lucas; his parents, Bob and Betty Smith, Bismarck; two brothers, Gary, New Town, and Gordy, Bismarck; three sisters and brothers-in-law, Julie and Jerry Nachatilo, Butte; Barb and Steve Grabar and Kathy and Duane Materi; Bismarck; and his grandmothers, Mrs. Ada Smith, Bismarck; and Mrs. Leona Kilmer, Minot.

# Bismarck American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1989 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams. The Governors, Royals, and Scarlets. Our goal in 1989 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 55 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Williston and the State Tournament in West Fargo. The 1989 "AA" All-Star game is slated in Bismarck, July 23rd.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The state champion then enters a Regional Tournament against South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri champions and a host team. The winner of that tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "A" teams - the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 14-15 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately thirty games with practices beginning the middle of May, the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m., and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform, cap, and carrying bag. The players furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome any interested youth between 14

and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club which donates a portion of the costs of the program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and it's Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services, and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

The program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the fame of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Babe Ruth Program. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The Babe Ruth League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Babe Ruth League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills.

Coaches for Babe Ruth League teams are people who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.





## Wayne Horner

### GOVERNORS COACH

Coach Horner is a fourteen year veteran of the Bismarck Legion Baseball Program. Wayne was first in uniform during the 1975 season as a batboy. Wayne was a member of the Governors 1982 State Championship Team, and during the 1983 season led the team in all offensive categories.

Upon completing his Legion eligibility, Wayne accepted a scholarship to play baseball for Central Arizona College at Coolidge, Arizona, where midway in his freshman season he switched from second base to third base, and during his two years at Central Arizona was no lower than third in the offensive team statistics in any category.

Wayne accepted a baseball scholarship to the University of Northern Alabama at Florence, Alabama to complete his 3rd year of college. He graduated from the University of North Dakota in 1987 and is attending UND Law School.



## Brent Voegele

### GOVERNORS ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Voegele is a veteran of the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program. Prior to college he played legion baseball with the Bismarck Governors and Bismarck Royals. He was a Bismarck Governor pitcher three years, earning All-Star status and MVP honors two years running. He also participated in three American Legion State Baseball Tournaments.

Brent recently concluded his last year of varsity baseball at the University of North Dakota. He was a varsity baseball player 4 years and earned three varsity letters at UND. He also earned the honors of Scholastic All-American and Academic All-Conference honorable mention while at UND.

He has been active in the youth baseball program in Bismarck. During the past three summers Brent has worked as a coach with the Bismarck Park and Recreation Department youth baseball program. Last summer he also coached in the Babe Ruth program in Bismarck, in which his team won the city championship. He also coached the Babe Ruth All-Star team which played in the State Tournament in Valley City.

This is Brent's first season as Assistant Coach of the Bismarck Governors.





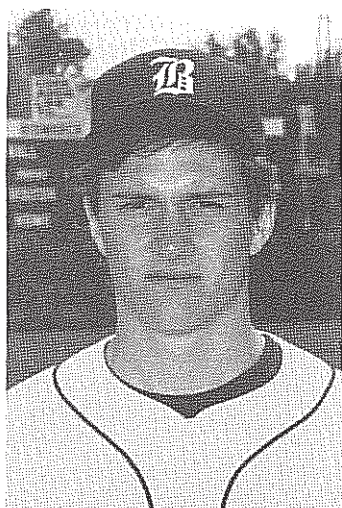
