



Governors' Coaches

MIKE SKYTLAND: Coach



This is Coach Skytland's sixth year as Head Coach for the Governors. Last year, the Governors were the State Seeding Tournament Champion and North Dakota State Class 'A' American Legion Runners-up. The Governors were also the State Runner-up under Skytland in 2005 and 2007. Prior to becoming the Head Coach, Skytland was the Bismarck Governor's Assistant Coach for three years. Coach Skytland was selected to help coach the Class 'A' West Team in the 2008 North Dakota East-West American Legion Baseball All-Star Classic.

Before BGovs: Coach Skytland has been a coach with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District's summer baseball program since 1988. During his years with Parks and Recreation, Skytland has been involved with Babe Ruth Baseball and served as the coordinator for the 13-15 year-old Babe Ruth Program from 1995-2000. Several of Coach Skytland's teams won state championships at the Bambino (1993, 1995); 13-year-old (1993, 1994, 1997); and 14-year-old (1999) levels. His 1995 Bambino and 2000 15-year-old teams both won the Midwest Plains Regional Championship and placed fifth at the Babe Ruth World Series.

Off the field: Coach Skytland just completed his eighth year as a teacher at Bismarck High School where he teaches Economics and U.S. History. Coach Skytland also serves as an assistant boy's basketball coach. Previously, he taught six years at St. Mary's Grade School. Coach Skytland was the University of Mary's Head Men's Tennis Coach from 1993-2008 and also served as the Head Women's Tennis Coach from 2001-2008. During the off-season, Skytland is an Instructor for the Midwest Baseball Academy Spring Camp at Bismarck State College.

BLAINE STEINER: Assistant Coach




This is Coach Steiner's sixth year as Assistant Coach for the Governors. Steiner is also the web administrator for the Bismarck Governors web page, www.bgovs.org.

Before BGovs: Coach Steiner has been a coach with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation summer baseball program for over 18 years, starting in 1988. During his years with Parks and Recreation, Steiner has been involved with Babe Ruth Baseball since 1989 and served as the coordinator for the 13-15 year-old Babe Ruth Program in 2001. Steiner was an assistant coach on Mike Skytland's teams that won state championships at the Bambino (1993); 13-year-old (1993); and 14-year-old (1999) levels. Their 1995 Bambino and 2000 15-year-old teams both won the Midwest Plains Regional Championship and placed fifth at the Babe Ruth World Series. In 2003, Coach Steiner's 13-year-old Babe Ruth team won the state championship and competed in the Midwest Plains Regional.

Off the field: Coach Steiner just completed his ninth year as an Assistant Professor and the Athletic Training Program Director at "America's Leadership University", the University of Mary. He

has over 16 years of athletic training experience including work with the Sioux Falls Stampede of the United States Hockey League and the Frappier Acceleration Programs in Bismarck and Minot; and Medcenter One Health Systems in Bismarck providing athletic training services to area high schools. Blaine is serving his third term as Vice-President of the North Dakota Athletic Trainers' Association (NDATA). During the off-season, Steiner is an Instructor for the University of Mary Marauders Baseball Camp and the Midwest Baseball Academy Spring Camp at Bismarck State College. Steiner also volunteers his time to help with the Open Your Heart Campaign sponsored by the Legionnaires of Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 of the American Legion.
