Rob Montgomery is a Bismarck native and a graduate of the Bismarck Legion Baseball Program. He was a member of the 1971 State Championship team.



American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck American Legion baseball program consists of three teams:

The varsity or "AA" team that plays a forty to fifty game regular season schedule against teams in both

Dakota's, Montana, and Minnesota.

The "AA" team is limited to eighteen players under the National American Legion baseball rules. Under this rule a team can register only players eighteen years of age and younger for post season play. (The cutoff date is August 1, 1960.

The Royals or "A" team that plays a thirty game schedule against teams in the general Bismarck area. The purpose of the Jr. Varsity is to expose fourteen, fifteen, and sixteen year olds to a better brand of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending all of the practice time on the basic fundamentals of the game.

The squad will be composed of eighteen players and whenever games are played we will try to schedule doubleheaders so that everyone will have an opportunity to start one of the games, if possible. The team will play a thirty game schedule with practice beginning the middle of May and the season ending around

August 1st.

Weather permitting, we will practice everyday that a game is not scheduled. Most of the games will be played during the week leaving the week-ends free to be spent with the respective families. Our practices will usually begin around 12:30 p.m. and they will last for two hours.

Each team member will be provided a uniform for the season. The players will have to provide their own

gloves, shoes and personal equipment.

Games will be scheduled against Jr. Varsity teams from Mandan, Dickinson, Jamestown, area varsity "A" teams, plus we will possibly be participating in an Early Bird tournament against some "AA" varsity teams.

We welcome all candidates of this age bracket to try out and around June 1st a squad cut will be necessary

to establish an eighteen man squad.

The Scarlets or "B" team that plays a twenty game schedule against area "Babe Ruth" teams.

The Rookie League program is a cooperative effort of the Bismarck Parks and Recreation and the Bismarck

American Legion Baseball Committee.

Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop the baseball skills that will allow these young people to enjoy and understand the game so as to become better participants and spectators.

The league consists basically of persons who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop the baseball skill of the players.

The more-skilled players, who are interested in furthering their baseball participation, are eligible to compete on the American Legion sponsored All-Star Team which will be chosen from Rookie League players to compete in outside games. It is proposed that this All-Star Team have a rotating roster to allow more players to participate during the course of the season. Players on the All-Star Team roster must continue Rookie League participation. Every effort will be made to prevent conflict of All-Star Team games and Rookie League Games.

Coaches for Rookie League teams are volunteer adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball

Program.

For the past few years the Bismarck American Legion program has been financed by concerned businesses that have donated money to enable the Bismarck Legion Committee to administer a fine program. Their donations are recognized yearly on the back cover of the varsity programs.

This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball like they never knew it before, and belong to a prestigious organization such as

American Legion Baseball.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season each division has a tournament to decide which team will represent that division in the State Tournament. The top two finishers in the "AA" tournaments and the top finishers of four class "A" tournaments meet in a State Tournament to decide the State Champion. The Champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota, Minnesota, lowa, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to a National Tournament to determine the National Champion.



MIKE FORDYCE Scarlets Coach

Mike is a four year veteran of the Bismarck Legion Program. He is presently attending Mankato State University. He lettered in baseball in both his freshman and sophomore years for the varsity at Mankato. He presently is their first string catcher for the varsity. Mike played various positions when he played his Legion Ball at Bismarck. Mike pitched a no-hitter against a strong Fargo Legion squad in his last year in the Legion Program.

Mike will also be heading up the Rookie League

Program for the Bismarck Park System.








TODD ZACHER



TERRY WOLF






MARK KRENZ




BRENT LICK

north dakota national guard tuition waiver program



eligibility

Any active North Dakota National Guardsman presently serving in either the Army Guard or the Air Guard who meets the following requirements, may have up to 75 per cent of the tuition fee per academic year waived.

Non-Prior Service Personnel

- 1. Sign an enlistment contract to serve with the NDNG under the provisions of one of the current programs offered.
- 2. Complete, as a minimum, Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training or the equivalent unless waived by the approving authority.

tuition waiver program

You may be eligible to attend the college of your choice at only one-fourth the normal tuition thanks to a new law, the Tuition Waiver Act. This law was passed by the 1977 North Dakota Legislative Assembly and became effective July 1, 1977. Strong support for the act was given by the North Dakota National Guard Officers' Association, the Enlisted Association, and the office of the Adjutant General.


