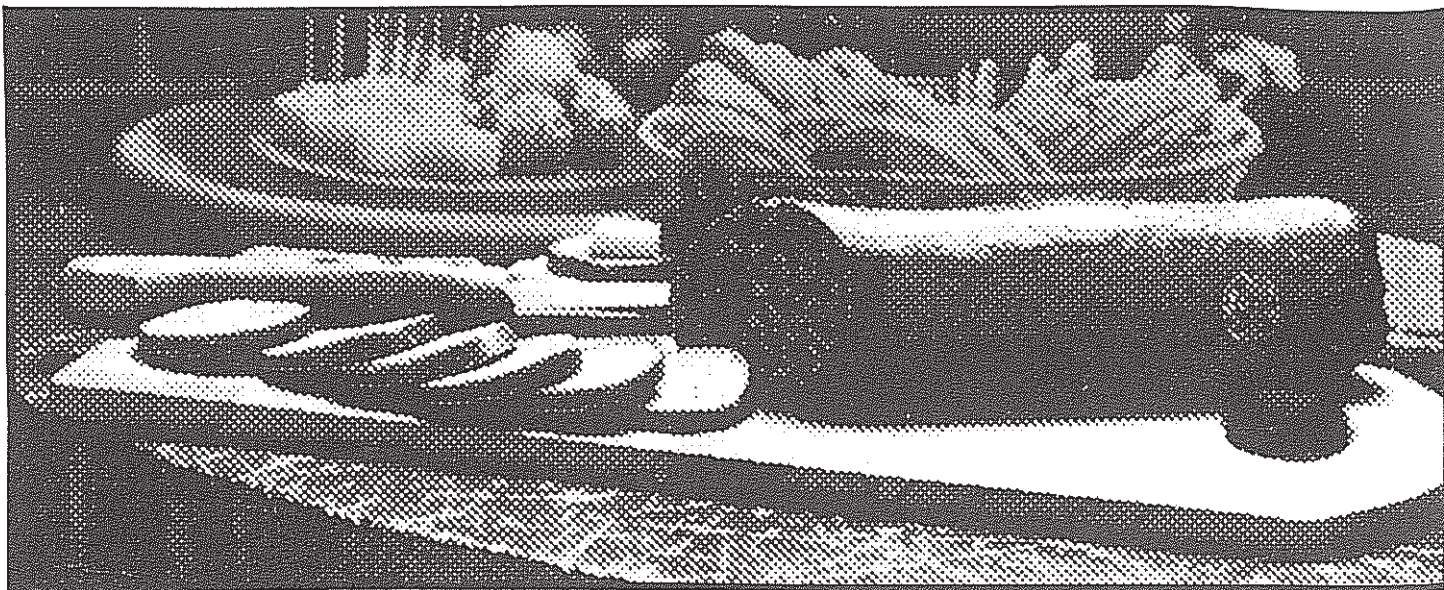

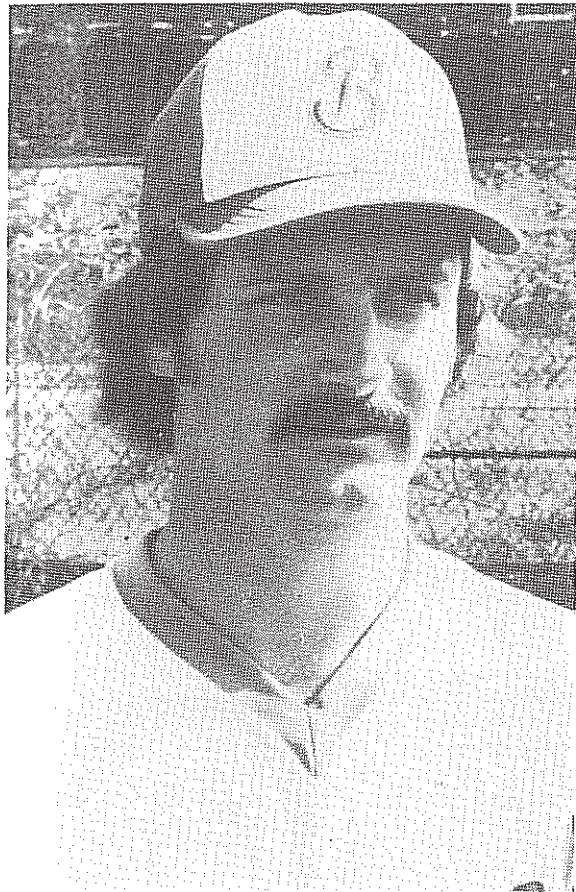

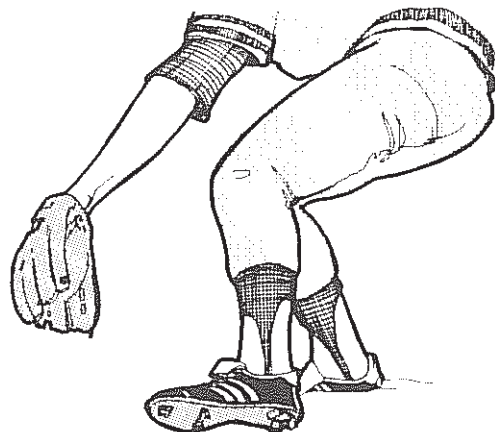


ROBERT MONTGOMERY — coach

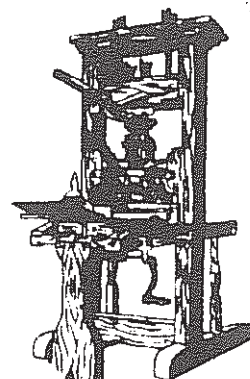

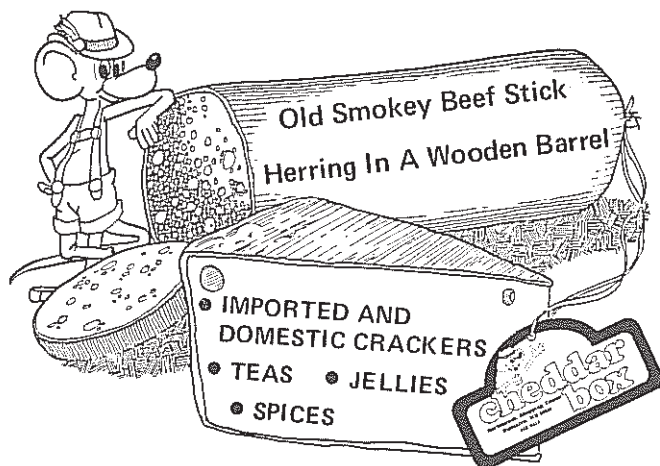


LEN STANLEY — coach

BISMARCK AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball program for 1979 will consist of three teams:

The varsity or "AA" squad that will play a fifty-seven game schedule. The 1979 schedule for the varsity will include participating in four in season tournaments, the Bismarck Invitational, Aberdeen, South Dakota, Sheridan, Wyoming, and Billings, Montana. Along with these road trips several others are planned, to Rapid City, Fargo, Grand Forks area, and to the Minneapolis - St. Paul area. Included in the "AA" schedule with these road trips will be games against all of the other "AA" teams in North Dakota.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The top two finishers in the "AA" tournaments and the top finishers of four class "A" tournaments meet in a State Tournament to decide the State Champion. The Champion then enters a Regional Tournament against the South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of this tournament advances to a National Tournament to determine the National Champion.

This year the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program is going to sponsor two "A" teams, the Royals and the Scarlets. With the number of returning players we'll have in addition to those moving up from the Rookie League it was decided to have two teams to accommodate everyone.

Each squad will be composed of fifteen to eighteen players in the 13 to 16 year old age bracket. The teams will play a thirty-six game schedule with practice beginning the middle of May and the season ending around August 1st. Games will be scheduled with Dickinson, Mandan, Minot, Jamestown, area varsity "A" teams and against each other. We will also host a mid-season tournament and the season will be concluded with each team participating in a District Tournament with the opportunity of advancing to a regional and state competition. Most games during the season will be scheduled during the week leaving week-ends free to be spent with the respective families.

Weather permitting, we will practice everyday that a game is not scheduled. Practices will usually begin

at 12:30 p.m. and last for two to three hours. Both teams will practice together and squad members for each team will be chosen by position. An attempt will be made to make the teams as even as possible.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform, jacket and carrying bag. The players will have to furnish their own gloves, shoes and personal equipment.

We welcome all candidates of this age bracket to try out. This is your opportunity to be exposed to a better caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending all of the practice time on the basic fundamentals of the game. Also, by going to a two team concept we should not have to cut anyone and you will have the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

The past two years the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program has been financed by the Bismarck Legion Club, that donates a substantial sum of money for this program and by concerned businesses in the Bismarck-Mandan area. This financial assistance has enabled the Bismarck Legion Committee to administer a fine program.

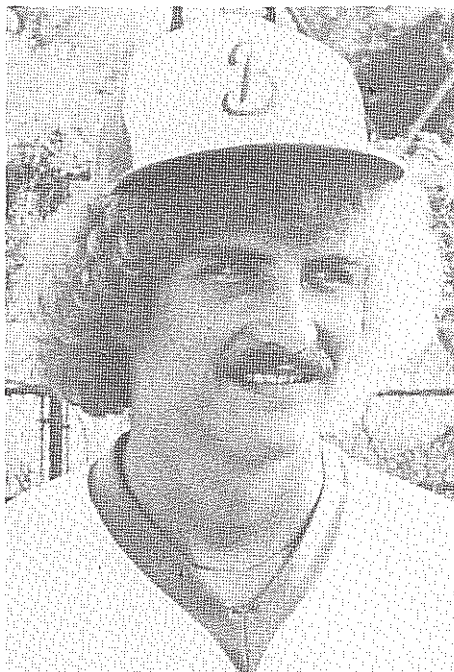
This program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball like they never knew it before, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball program along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Rookie League.

Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop the baseball skills that will allow these young people to enjoy and understand the game so as to become better participants and spectators.

The league consists basically of persons who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Rookie League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop the baseball skill of the players.

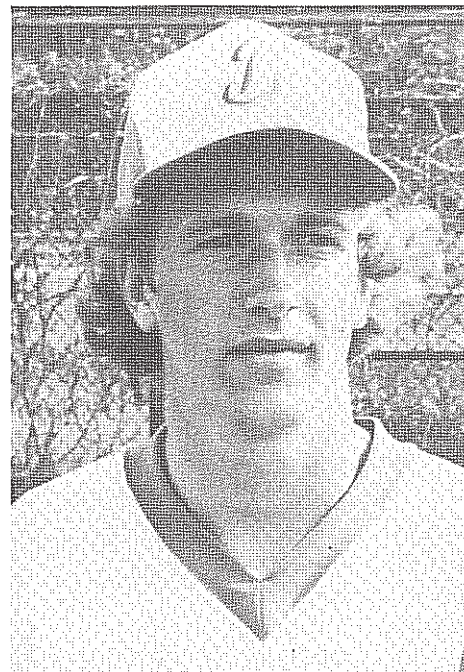
Coaches for Rookie League teams are young adults who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.
