Bismarck American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1990 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams. The Governors, Boyals, and Scarlets. Our goal in 1990 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 55 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Minot at the State Tournament in Mandan.

North Dakota American Legion baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The state champion then enters a Regional Tournament against South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri champions and a host team. The winner of that tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "A" teams the Royals and Scarlets. Each squad will consist of 14-15 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket. Each team will play approximately thirty games with practices beginning the middle of May, the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a district tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. The Royals practice time is 12:30 p.m., and the Scarlets practice time is 10:00 a.m. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

Each team member will be provided with a uniform, cap, and carrying bag. The players furnish their own gloves, shoes, and personal equipment.

We welcome any interested youth between 14

and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.


Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1, which donates a portion of the costs of the program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and its Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services, and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

The program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the fame of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsor the Bismarck Babe Ruth Program. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The Babe Ruth League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Babe Ruth League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills.

Coaches for Babe Ruth League teams are people who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.

GOVERNORS COACH

Coach Breuer is beginning his 22nd year as a coach in the Bismarck American Legion Program. Al is a graduate of Wyndmere High School and North Dakota State, where he participated in varsity baseball and basketball. His Royals' teams won 470 games and lost 224, won 13 district tournaments, 2 regional championships, 2nd place in three other regional tournaments and 3rd place in the Class A State Tournament in 1980 and 1989.

For the 1987 season Coach Breuer was named runner-up for the North Dakota Amateur Baseball Coach Of the Year Award by the United States Baseball Federation.

In Bismarck, Al teaches at Hughes Jr. High, where he is the athletic director, and also coaches football and basketball. Coach Breuer and his wife Karen are the parents of two children - Tana, a student at the University of North Dakota, and Jim, who will be a junior at Century High School.



Jeff Schulz

GOVERNORS ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Schulz is a veteran of the Bismarck American Legion Baseball program. Jeff was first in uniform during the 1985 season as a member of the Royals, and then went on to play four years for the Governors from 1986 through 1989. During his Legion career, he was named Most Improved Player in 1986, Offensive MVP in 1988, MVP in 1988 and Defensive MVP in 1989. He was a State Finalist in 1988 for Amateur Baseball Player of the Year. He participated in two All-Star games and three state tournaments, and was on the Governors 1986 State Championship team.

Upon completing his Legion eligibility, Jeff accepted a scholarship to play baseball at Howard College in Big Spring, Texas. During his freshman year he was no lower than third in the offensive team statistics in any category. He was one of two Howard College baseball players to be named to the All Region V baseball team. Howard College was one of 8 teams to capture a recent berth in the Texas Junior College State Baseball Tournament and was ranked number nine in the nation in the final regular season poll.



Coach Severson is a teacher in the Bismarck Public School System. He is active in the supervision of boys' intramural activities, basketball coaching, and is the coordinator of the girls' elementary basketball program for Bismarck Public Schools.

Gene was a supervisor and coordinator of youth baseball for the Bismarck Parks and Recreation for 12 years before joining the American Legion Program. He was instrumental in organizing the Rookie League Baseball Program in 1977, the forerunner of the present Babe Ruth Program for 13-15 year olds. Coach Severson served as the varsity assistant during the 1978 season and has been the Scarlets coach since 1979.

Gene was the recipient of the Norwest Bank sponsored "Gold Award" in December, 1980 for his service and dedication to the youth of Bismarck. The Northridge Elementary School gymnasium was named and dedicated in his honor in September of 1988 for 25 years of coaching and supervising elementary sports programs at Northridge.

Each player is asked to participate by selling tickets and helping with the food service. Many of our parents also participate as evidenced by the pictures.






ROYALS COACH

This is Brent's second season as an American Legion coach and his first season as Head Coach of the Bismarck Royals.





Rield Position

Pitcher. Everything starts with the pitcher and every pitcher has a favorite pitch he tends to throw when he needs an out. The hard fast ball is the best weapon for a pitcher. Other pitches are soft and hard curves, sliders which break just as they reach the plate, slow change-ups released with a fastball motion to put the batter offstride, and rare deliveries such as fork balls and knuckleballs.

Catcher. The field general. With help from the manager or coach, the catcher calls the pitches and sets the defense.

First Baseman. Generally the weakest-fielding or slowest player on the field, but usually a good hitter needed by the offense. He does make most of the put-outs when he is in the field.

Second Baseman. A position that de-

mands much skill, the second baseman frequently is the middle man on doubleplay attempts when baserunners try to mislead him. He also is the relay man on many throws from the outfield to home plate.

Third Baseman. With the exception of the pitcher, the third baseman plays closer to the batter than any other fair-territory fielder. There isn't much time to think about what he is going to do. That's why they call it a "reaction" position.

Shortstop. Generally the best fielder on the team, the shortstop must have good speed to get to ground balls hit into the "hole," the space between second and third bases.

Left Field. The remarkable thing about left field is that many good outfielders can't play there because of the different angle from which the fly balls and line drives come off the bat. A good left fielder must be able to dig out hits from the corners to prevent runners from taking extra bases.

Centre Field. This is where the fastest outfielder normally plays because the centre field fence is the farthest from the plate. A good centre fielder must have a strong arm. He is the captain of the outfield.

Right Field. Traditionally, the strongest-armed outfielder plays in right. Like the left fielder, he also must be able to dig out hits from the corner to prevent runners from turning doubles into triples.

Designated Hitter. One of the newest rules in baseball allows a better batter to hit for th epitcher. The designated hitter normally is a good batter who is not an accomplished fielder.

Dimensions


Home Plate - The plate has five irregular sides. The side facing the pitcher is 17 inches, two sides are 81/2 inches and the two others are each 12 inches. The extensions of these last two reach to first and third bases as far as the fences, marking the limits of the foul lines.


Batter's Box — On each side of the plate is a white rectangle, four feet wide by six feet deep, called the batter's box. The batter must remain within these limits to hit the ball.

Pltchers Mound — The pitcher's plate, a white rectangular piece of whitened rubber, 24 inches by 6 inches, is 10 inches above the level of home plate. The distance between the pitching rubber and the plate (the rear point of the plate) is 60 feet, 6 inches.


