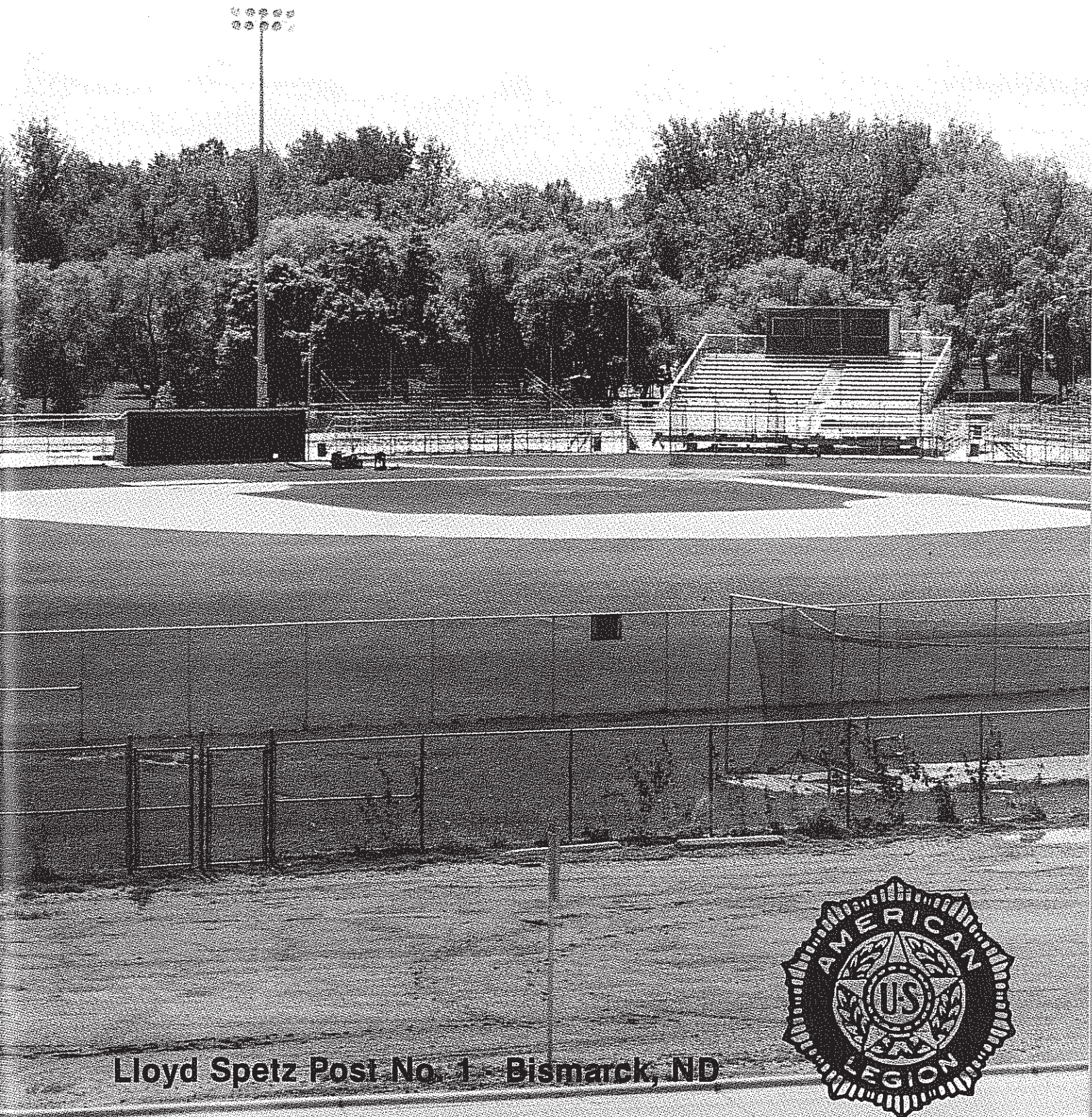

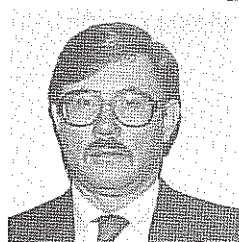

Thanks to the organization and businesses that have supported us in the past and again this year. With community support it has made baseball an excellent summer program. Thanks again.

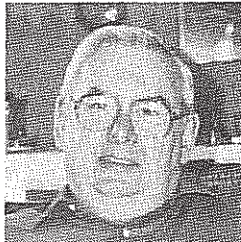

American Legion Baseball

The Bismarck 1993 American Legion Baseball Program will consist of three teams - the Governors, Royals, and Scarlets. Our goal in 1993 is that all interested ballplayers be given the opportunity to play Legion baseball in Bismarck. The Governors, our "AA" varsity team, will play about a 55 game schedule. Post-season play will include the Western Division Tournament in Dickinson and the State Tournament in Devils Lake.

North Dakota American Legion Baseball is set in two divisions geographically, East and West. Bismarck is a member of the Western Division along with Mandan, Dickinson, Minot, and Williston. At the end of the regular season, each division has a tournament to decide which teams will represent that division in the State Tournament. The state champion then enters a Regional Tournament against South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas, and Missouri Champions and a host team. The winner of that tournament advances to the American Legion World Series to determine the National Champion.

This season the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program will again sponsor two "A" teams - the Scarlets and Royals. The Scarlets will consist of about 16 players in the 15 and 16 year age bracket, and will play approximately 50 games. The Royals will carry about 16 players in the 14 to 16 year age bracket, and will play about 40 games. Practices begin in the middle of May, with the season concluding around the first part of August with participation in a District Tournament. There is an opportunity to advance to Regional and State competition for the district winner. Most games are scheduled during the week in order to leave weekends free for family activities.

Weather permitting, practices are held each day that games are not scheduled. Squad members are chosen by position in an effort to make each team equally competitive.

We welcome any interested youth between 14 and 16 years of age to try out for this program. It is an opportunity to be exposed to

a high caliber of baseball in preparation for a varsity career. This is accomplished by spending the practice times on the basic fundamentals of the game. Although roster numbers are limited, we are hopeful that the two-team structure will allow any interested young man the opportunity to become a quality baseball player.

Historically, the Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program has been financed by the Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1, which donates a portion of the costs of the program. The Lloyd Spetz Post No. 1 and its Athletic Committee are particularly grateful for the money, services, and time donated by the many individuals, organizations, and businesses which is a vital part of funding this program.

The Program has much to offer any young man that is involved with it. Along with providing an opportunity to play baseball at a top-notch level, it can provide an opportunity to make friends, to do some traveling, learn the game of baseball, and belong to a prestigious organization such as American Legion Baseball.

The Bismarck American Legion Baseball Program, along with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation also co-sponsors the Bismarck Babe Ruth Program. Although the major objective we wish to achieve is a recreational activity for this age group, we also wish to develop baseball skills to enable participants to become better players and fans.

The Babe Ruth League consists of young athletes who have completed the 7th, 8th, and 9th grades. Players graduating from the Youth Baseball Program into the Babe Ruth League will find a more organized, more disciplined, more competitive type of baseball in order to develop their baseball skills.

Coaches for Babe Ruth League teams are people who have an interest in the development of youth and their talents. Whenever possible, the umpires for regular league games are chosen from the assistant supervisors of the Parks and Recreation Youth Baseball Program.

Coach Schroeder is a 1964 graduate of St. Mary's New England and a 1968 college graduate of Dickinson State where he participated in football, basketball and baseball.

Coach Schroeder has 24+ years of teaching and coaching experience, nineteen of which were spent in Belfield. He was legion coach for the years 1968 and 1969 at New England, both of which were State Tournament entrants. He was head coach for Dickinson Legion in 1990 and 1991. Dickinson was a State entrant in '91. He also played 21 years of amateur baseball during the years 1966 through 1986.

Coach Schroeder and his wife Tammy are parents of two children, Dara age 12 and Sharona age 9.

This is coach Schroeder's second year as head coach of the Governors.

Coach Sprynczynatyk is a four year veteran of the Bismarck American Legion program. He played legion baseball with the Bismarck Governors and the Bismarck Royals.

With the Bismarck Governors he was a pitcher/outfielder for two years, earning the Most Improved Player and the Leading Hitter awards his final season. In his final season on the Royals team he also earned the team pitching award.

He participated in two American Legion State Baseball Tournaments, and was a member of the 1989 Governors State Runner-up team.

Jason just completed his Junior year at the University of North Dakota. This is his second season as Assistant Coach of the Bismarck Governors.

Dear Mom and Dad,

"I hope you won't get mad at me for writing this letter, but you always told me never to hold anything back and to bring it out in the open. So here goes . . . it's about Baseball."

"You're always embarrassing me. Yesterday when I went for an extra base trying to score, I fell, and well, Mom, I could hear you yelling at the catcher for tagging me out. Gosh, Mom, it wasn't his fault. He's supposed to keep me from scoring."

"Then do you remember yelling at me to get closer to the base? Well, gee I didn't know what to do then, cuz the coach told me to play my position and I couldn't if I listened to you. So while I tried to decide what to do, the other team scored against us. Then you yelled at me for being in the wrong place. I wish you'd yell some good things at us sometimes."

"Dad, you're always yelling to hit a home run, gosh, I'd rather just hit a single than sit on the bench because I struck out. Besides, my coach tells me to just try to make contact with the ball and get on base. That way it's a team game and everyone is contributing no matter if we win or lose. I'm not saying that all coaches teach that way, but our coach tells us we've got lots of time to learn how to hit for power and homeruns."

"But what really got me mad, Mom and Dad, was what happened after the game. You shouldn't have jumped on the coach for pulling me off the field. He's a pretty good coach and he knows when he needs a strong fielder. Besides he's a person who comes to the ball park at all hours to help us kids, cuz he likes sports and he likes kids. And then neither of you spoke to me the whole way home. I guess you think I'm just a lousy baseball player. And I guess I am. But I love baseball. I like being with the other kids and learning how to compete as a good sport in a really great sport."

I guess what I'm trying to say, Mom and Dad, is I wish you were good sports cuz I thought I was playing baseball for fun, to have a good time, to learn how to play a sport as a team member and learn sportsmanship."

"I didn't know you were going to be upset because I couldn't become a star."

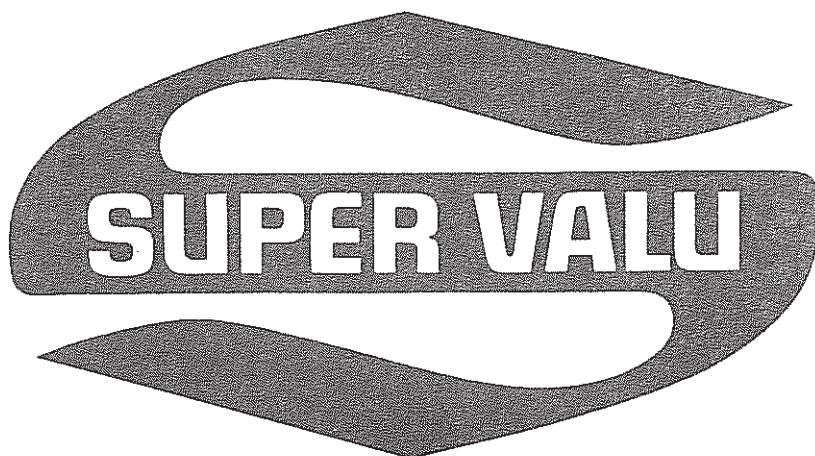
SCARLETS COACH

Coach Severson is a teacher in the Bismarck Public School System. He is active in the supervision of boys' intramural activities, basketball coaching, and is a coordinator of the girls' elementary basketball program for Bismarck Parks and Recreation.

Gene was a supervisor and coordinator of youth baseball for the Bismarck Parks and Recreation for 12 years before joining the American Legion Program. He was instrumental in organizing the Rookie League Baseball Program in 1977, the forerunner of the present Babe Ruth Program for 13-15 year olds.
